

What would I be doing as Programme Team Member for Squirrels?

Help Sections within the County to improve their programmes

- Support both District Squirrel Leads to share and make programme changes, such as new badges and activities.
- Promote, support and celebrate Chief Scout Acorn Award so District Squirrel Leads have the chance to create amazing experiences.

Set up activities and events in the County

- Organise County events when you work with District Squirrel Leads to identify they're needed, and make sure they're inclusive and accessible to all.
- Set up networking and peer support at County scale so Squirrels Team Leaders can share best practice across the County.

If you are passionate about growing and developing our youngest section and supporting other volunteers, then this is the role for you!
